

# Vermont Disability Status Overview

## State Profile



## Introduction

In **2011**, **24.9%** of adults in **Vermont** reported having a disability, compared with **24.4%** in the **United States and Territories**. The tables in this profile provide information on the percentage of adults with and without disability by age, sex, race/ethnicity, and veteran status. All data are from **2011**.

## Age

**Table 1. Disability status among age groups**

This table shows the percentage of adults in different age groups with and without a disability. For example, in **2011**, **17.6%** of adults 18-44 years of age, **30.1%** of adults 45-64 years of age, and **38.6%** of adults 65 years of age or older had a disability.

## Sex

**Table 2. Disability status among males and females**

This table shows the percentage of men and women with and without a disability. For example, in **2011**, **23.1%** of men and **26.4%** of women had a disability.

## Race/Ethnicity

**Table 3. Disability status among racial/ethnic groups**

This table shows the percentage of adults in different racial/ethnic groups with and without a disability. For example, in **2011**, **24.3%** of white, **DS%** of black, **31.4%** of Hispanic, **DS%** of Asian, **DS%** of Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, **42.8%** of American Indian or Alaska Native, and **51.0%** of other/multirace adults had a disability.

## Veteran Status

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**Table 4. Disability status among veterans and non-veterans**

This table shows the percentage of veterans and non-veterans with and without a disability. For example, in **2011**, **30.7%** of veterans and **24.5%** of non-veterans had a disability.

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1. All data are from the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (<http://www.cdc.gov/BRFSS/>). Beginning in 2011, BRFSS made changes to both the sampling and weighting methodologies used. As such, estimates from 2011 and beyond are not comparable to estimates prior to 2011.
2. Estimates are for adults 18 years of age or older unless otherwise indicated.
3. Estimates are age-adjusted to the 2000 U.S. standard population.
4. P-values are available beginning with the 2011 BRFSS data.
